Comment text:

I am glad that Giffard Park now shares a ward with the majority of Great Linford Parish, rather than being linked to Newport Pagnell. However, I personally believe that including Redhouse Park in this ward will cause issues. Wolverton Road forms a barrier, and it goes all the way from Newport Pagnell to New Bradwell relatively uninterrupted. Including Redhouse Park means that the ward is forced to straddle that natural border. Though Giffard Park and Redhouse Park are both in Great Linford Parish Council, they have different characters and different priorities - the Lidl built on Wolverton Road, which was met with frustration south of Wolverton Road and the parish, was backed by many Redhouse Park residents who felt existing services in Giffard Park were too far. That should be evidence enough that this is not a logical economic or community link, and I believe Redhouse Park should be linked to Hanslope and New Bradwell, as this would place them with more natural partners, like Oakridge Park and new developments in Hanslope around the Harvington Crescent and De Beauchamp Avenue area - new-build estates that nowhere else in your Great Linford Ward has.
