I live in Great Holm, which I understand is to move into the Bradwell Ward. I do not understand this decision, as we look towards Loughton and Crownhill for our goods, services, and community links. However, I've seen enough of these boundary reviews now to know the chances of this being changed is minimal.

However, it adds insult to injury that the ward I am now in is named after Bradwell, a tiny village in the ward that doesn't reflect Great Holm whatsoever (and neither does it reflect Two Mile Ash, or Heelands, and on top of that, is liable to confuse residents of Bradwell Common, who despite sharing a parish with Bradwell, are not in the ward). I hope you will explore naming the ward after something more reflective. "Two Mile Ash" would represent the single largest part of the ward, and the bit that joins all the sections; "Abbey Hill" as the parish name may work also. "Heelands & Great Holm" would reflect the new city developments. Any of these names would work, but all I ask is that you do not call the new ward Bradwell, as that name means nothing to me or my neighbours.
