

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The District of Cotswold (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2025

Made: 26TH JUNE 2025

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Cotswold District Council (“the Council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a Community Governance Review and made recommendations dated the: 19th of March 2025.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement(a)

1(1) This Order may be cited as the District of Cotswold (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2025.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 26TH JUNE 2025

Interpretation

2. —In this Order—

“district” means the district of Cotswold;

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in The District of Cotswold (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2025 and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a lettered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that letter;

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8(c) of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3.—(1) This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

(2) Save, as set out in this Order, the existing parishes in the District of Cotswold, and the existing names, boundaries, council size and other parish governance arrangements in respect of those parishes, shall remain existing.

Electoral register

4.—The registration officer for the District shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Alteration of parish areas

5.—Great Rissington and Upper Rissington

(1) The area coloured purple on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Great Rissington and shall become part of the parish of Upper Rissington.

Order date

6.26th JUNE 2015 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
