Comment text:

I am emailing on behalf of Hodsock Parish Council regarding the current electoral review being carried out for Bassetlaw District Council. Hodsock Parish Council have reviewed the data and feel that we are under represented with only one councillor going forward for Langold. The Data shows currently we have an electorate of 1976 which is approximately 7% above the average councillor per elector. Your data estimates this to increase to 2531 by 2030 which equates to 25% above the average councillor per elector. We feel that this is gravely underestimated as we have at present a development of 470 houses being built within Langold most of which are family homes. We would assume that most of these houses will have at least 2 adults living in them which would give an increase of nearly 1000, not the 555 that has been predicted. This would result in nearly 3000 electorates (48% above the average councillor per electorate). With this in mind we feel that having only one councillor to represent nearly 3000 people is not sufficient and would ask that this be increased to 2 councillors.
