Having looked at the plans I'm really dissapointed to see Selby East has been carved up seemingly with no thought for the communities within it. Staynor Hall naturally links with Abbots Road and it would be a mistake splitting this area moving part of it in to Barlby over a river and in to a different Parish council whilst it still remains part of Selby Town Council. This would be confusing and would split an area that share transport links and in dome instances schools and facilities. The bypass should be used as the boundary for this ward and it should be left as it is now with Orkney wood drive and the lidl site added at this end. The boundary across at Leeds road and Westbourne Road should then revert to what it is now instead of splitting residential streets in half further confusing the situation. Selby West should then take Leeds Road in its entirety as it is now and potentially the Westbourne part keeping it as a 2 person ward as is proposed for Sherburn. Slicing the town up as it has been proposed would not only put areas of Selby with nothing in common together while moving others out of the Town that should naturally stay as part of the town. It's common sense in my opinion snd would make for a more cohesive and effective boundaries for residents and those looking to represent them.
