Looking at the map, there seems to be too many Division ares (why are there 2 around Ripon) and the part south of Wetherby, including Tadcaster & Selby, seems almost disconnected with the rest of the County. I realise this is a result of previous changes to the boundaries but it results in an anomalous whole and leads to Parliamentary Constituencies such as Wetherby & Easingwold which is huge in area & includes two different local government areas.
