I am a councillor representing the current Houghton and Irthington ward on the Cumberland council, having previously represented this ward on Cumbria County council.

I can see no valid reason why this area combined with urban Carlisle north of the river Eden should be made a huge three-member ward when the rest of Cumberland is split into single member wards. This would clearly cause confusion to the public as well as other partner Organisations.

I have during my time as an elected member had first hand experience of single member wards as well as dual member wards and am of the clear view that single member wards work better. It gives clear lines of communication and accountability and avoids the likelihood of duplication. Inevitably councillors have different styles and methods which can be difficult to accommodate.

The three ward option for North Carlisle and Houghton would be in my view preferable as Houghton and the surrounding small hamlets are distinctly of a more Rural nature benefiting from a cohesive community very well served by a proactive Parish Council "Stanwix Rural". The Addition of the Knowfield area would in my view provide balance and be recognisable to the residents of the more rural parts of the proposed new ward.
