wards

We are proposing:

- 61 councillors
- 24 wards
- Eleven two-councillor wards
and thirteen three-councillor
wards

September 2026**



We aim to make sure Warrington
councillors represent a similar
number of electors

- Four wards that are more
than 10% away from the
average number of electors
per ward
- No wards that are more than
30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than
10% away from the average
number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent
an average of 2,822 electors
