Good morning Ben,
You should have received the following submission from the Council including practical views for which I apologise

- Castle Point is a Borough with four distinct urban settlements – South Benfleet, Canvey Island, Hadleigh and Thundersley therefore any warding pattern, and potentially naming of the new wards, should be based around these four areas as residents most closely identify with these
- Canvey Island is distinct from the mainland, and both from a practical and community perspective a ward split between these two areas would not work
- There are three caravan/mobile home parks in the Borough – Kingsleigh Park (Cedar Hall Ward), Kings Park Village (Canvey Island North Ward) and Sandy Bay Park/Thorney Bay Park (split between Canvey Island West Ward and Canvey Island South Ward) – which should not be split between wards as there is potential for housing units to be moved within the boundaries of these sites
- Boyce Ward is currently largely unpopulated in the centre with the majority of the development around the edges of the ward, so there is potential to combine the houses on the outskirts of this ward with the adjacent developments
