### Comment text:

Why is there a Baldock East? Why not just have 4 councillors representing Baldock as a whole? Baldock East effectively contains the train station (used by all in Baldock) taps Garden centre (used by all in Baldock) a primary school and a single general small store (mainly used by those on Clothall common) - everyone North of Royston Road does not have the same local concerns as those on Clothall (for example CLothall is not concerned with overspill from the tran station car park. The problems in Baldock Town (e.g. reduced services at the GP surgery) effect everyone in Baldock as a whole and have a false separation is unnecessary - the numbers do not make sense either - Baldock East has 25% bigger electorate than Baldock town per councillor. The wards need to operate not based on road and rail boundaries (except for motorways or lack fo rail crossings) but as something able to operate as individual entities with the necessary services contained within each (think GP, Dental services, schools, shops, post offices and public houses)- if a ward does not contain any/all of these it is not a functional ward.
