Comment text:

This comments are regarding the names of the wards. Fareham Park should be Fareham Highlands, as that the name most people identify the area as, as well as the road that goes right through the ward. Fareham Park refers to one road and covers a very small area. Avenue is a name that will not be recognised as a community, let alone a Council ward. I believe it should be left as Fareham West. I understand the Council's wishes to do away with "compass-point" names but Avenue, as a ward, doesn't even include the area east of Peak Lane stretching to Fareham College - so this will confuse the average voter even more. Meon - I have to say this name really baffled me as the new ward that has been proposed would fit extremely well staying as "Titchfield". My only comment on the wards themselves would be the Wallington & Downend ward, in which I would be a resident of, where there is due to be significant development, at both sides of Downend Road and part of Welbourne. I do not understand why it is 0% variance now when there will be a huge increase in residents over the next 10-20 years. Also, I see no real community links with Downend to the Old Turnpike/Park Lane area of Fareham, something I personally would consider Fareham Town or even Fareham North.
