Thank you for the opportunity to offer our thoughts on the proposed revision of ward boundaries of North Hertfordshire District. As noted in your proforma data there have been, and are expected to be, substantial changes to the distribution of the electorate through the existing wards.

We find that the NHC proposals are well argued and take account of the anticipated developments across the District. Consequently, the North Herts & Stevenage Green Party would be happy to support the changes proposed by NHC as well as increasing the number of councillors to 51 to accommodate the new Ward of Burloes in Royston.

Our only comment is that we would suggest that the new Ward boundary for Arbury should be renamed Ashwell as this is the main centre of population in the new Ward.
