Billericay and environs should be totally removed from Basildon Borough. We have nothing to do with Basildon - Basildon council has consistently ignored Billericay's needs for years. We should be in a Council with towns and villages more like ours - Mountnessing, Ingatestone, Stock, The Hanningfields. Take an area bordered by the A12, the A130 and the A127. Call it Billericay council. We used to have our own parliamentary constituency - it should be returned, alongside a local council district. Within that the wards representing Billericay, especially Billericay West and East are too large. Queen's Park is a discrete area with it's own identity. It should have a council seat of it's own, centred on Lake Meadows. Burstead covers a huge area including South Green which is part of Billericay, not Burstead. That should be rationalised with parts of Crouch ward, which is a really odd shape and looks totally artificial. Wickford has three seats, but is a very small town with large semi-rural areas tacked on. It should have one seat - centred on the town itself which has its own identity.
