Comment text:

There is an obvious disparity in representation, with (on forecast electorate) the councillor for Barkham representing nearly 4,000 electors, but a councillor for Coronation representing less than 1,000. Currently the Barkham councillor represents over 3,400 electors, whilst in 6 wards each councillor represents less than 2,200. Next only to Barkham in under-representation is Shinfield South. I suggest that Shinfield South is divided into two wards - Shinfield West (Grazeley, Three Mile Cross, Spencers Wood and Ryeish Green) and Shinfield East (Shinfield Village area). The forecast figures presumably do not take into account future development. For example, Arborfield's electorate is forecast to grow by just 5 people. If the Hall Farm development goes ahead, it will be considerably more. What plans are there for further revisions as new development takes place?
