Subject: East Hertfordshire (part) proposed boundary changes

Dear Sirs

East Hertfordshire

I propose that the Hertford Heath ward be divided at the current boundary with Brickendon Liberty and be linked to the ward of Great Amwell.

Hertford Heath electorate (est.2027) =1964; Great Amwell(") =1904; Total 3868 with 2 councillors.

That the well road linked Hertingfordbury, Bayford and Little Berkhamsted wards be joined with Brickendon Liberty parish to form a new Ward (could be named Hertford Rural).

Hertingfordbury electorate (est.2027) =562; Bayford = 399; Little Berkhamsted = 437;

Brickendon Liberty = 548; Total 1946 with 1 councillor.

The rationale is that the present ward of Hertford Heath is not connected by direct road, or other transport means, to the Brickendon Liberty parish, where as Brickendon Liberty is well connected to the other proposed ward members who are like villages.

Hertford Heath and Great Amwell are road linked in spite of the intervening A 10 dual carriageway under which there is a bridge.

There will be other changes needed in the surrounding wards to make sense of this proposal, however benefits to these rural communities would be gained from their likeness and that they will be simpler for councillors to canvas and administer.
