

This is the suggestion that I wish to make to the LGBCE on behalf of Bulk and Castle ward councillors. It is an extension of Castle ward eastwards to take in much more of the city centre and to increase the number of ward councillors to three. (As things stand, it is likely that University ward would revert to two councillors. But Morecambe and Skerton wards are over-represented too, relative to Bulk, Castle and Marsh.)

Bulk ward would lose enough electors to bring it nearer to the average three-member ward.

In detail, the proposal is to extend Castle ward eastwards to Lancaster canal. This means the whole of Canal Quarter, north of Moor Lane would move across. The resident population increase expected in Canal Quarter will take some time to realise. The northern boundary would thus be Bulk Rd/Factory Hill to the canal. That yields a total transfer (based on the December 2020 electoral register) of 1251 electors.
