Matchborough and Ipsley have a natural affinity with each other, sharing shopping schools leisure and entertainment. The New Town vision set by the Development Corporation was based on the Neighbourhood Principals each area Having its own centre with shops, amenities and leisure to ensure a sense of community and identity. Each district would have its own infrastructure and industry allowing the district as a whole to be a separate entity that can be characterised by its landscape locality emphasised by topographical conditions. Matchborough and Ipsley have clearly defined boundaries which separate it from other wards. The Arrow Valley Park to the west the A435 east and Warwick highway to the south.
