Therefore I wish to put forward my thoughts on how I feel is a good way to proceed on this matter.

1 Snodland can justify having four borough councillors instead of five.

2 it could be distributed as follows

Snodland NE (CGA) 2,421 Electors -0.3% with one Borough Councillor

Snodland West (CHA) 5,152

Snodland S (CGB) 1,473

Total electors 6,625 Electors -9% with three Borough Councillors

This method gives defined areas within Snodland that local people will understand. It also stops odd roads and streets being moved about randomly with no obvious reason for our residents.

As previously stated we absolutely have no wish to be joined with any other Parish as there is no common interests between us.

Finally I support Larkfield North 3,798 and

Larkfield South 3,632

Total 7, 430 Electors +2% having three Borough Councillors.
