### Comment text:

The current proposals for Breadsall Hilltop ward do not actually include Breadsall Hilltop itself. This is the name given to a section of the A608, known as Hilltop and in the proposals this falls within Oakwood ward. I would propose moving Breadsall Hilltop into the ward of the same name by amending the boundary to run along the A608 from the existing proposed boundary just north of Stratford Road to the city boundary at Nearwood Drive. This would take in the properties on Hilltop including two cul-de-sacs also known as Hilltop which are set back from the main road. These properties were built I think in the inter-war period (and certainly a long time before the Oakwood estate), and fit much more logically with Breadsall Hilltop than Oakwood. This would require that the new Dale Acre Way estate also comes into Breadsall Hilltop ward. I would not see this as a problem as it is a new estate and lacks any long term association with Oakwood. It could just as easily establish a community identity as Breadsall Hilltop. To compensate for this increased population in Breadsall Hilltop ward I would suggest keeping Wood Road and any offshoots, possibly including Wingfield Drive in Oakwood ward, which is the ward they are currently in, and which would prevent confusion caused by changing wards. I agree that the ward names Breadsall Hilltop, Chaddesden East, Chaddesden West and Oakwood are a good fit with the communities they cover.
