NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 54 councillors
- 24 wards
- 1 single-councillor ward, 16 two-councillor wards and 7 three-councillor wards

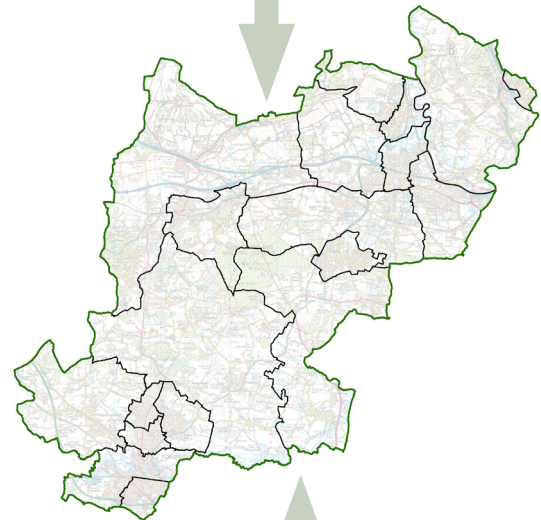
We are proposing:

- 44 councillors
- 19 wards
- 1 single-councillor ward, 11 two-councillor wards and 7 three-councillor wards

A public consultation is open until
13 December 2021



We aim to make sure Tonbridge and Malling councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 4 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- 1 ward that is more than 30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,428 electors
