Comment text:

We are concerned about the Bedhampton Ward. A small part of this ward is shown as CA on Havant PD map which is uploaded on my submission. This part of Bedhampton is known as West Bedhampton. It is in the far southwest of mainland Havant Borough and is out on a limb from the rest of Bedhampton. The houses in West Bedhampton have a natural boundary of B2177 to the north, A3M to the east, A27 to the south and Portsmouth City Council area to the west. All of the nearest facilities are to be found in the west within Portsmouth CC. Nearest schools, doctors, shopping are all in Portsmouth CC area all within walking distance. As the Portsmouth schools aren't within the catchment area school children have to go to Havant schools and have a very dangerous further route to walk, having to cross a large roundabout, with fast traffic from A3M, A27 and A2030. Even the polling station for West Bedhampton is located in the Portsmouth CC area. My suggestion is that the small area of West Bedhampton (CA) becomes part of Portsmouth as we are out on a limb from Bedhampton/Havant, the natural boundary is logically suited to be part of Portsmouth. Children would also have a safer and nearer route to school. Having previously lived in Portsmouth the services provided by Portsmouth CC are far superior to that of Havant.
