Comment text:

At an extraordinary full meeting of the Malvern Hills District Council on 26 July 2022, it was resolved (with 26 votes for and 4 against) that delegated authority be given to the Chief Executive to respond to the consultation on behalf of the Council on the following basis: a) Single member wards are generally preferred where these meet the statutory criteria; b) Southern Malvern Hills - Longdon & Welland: our strong preference is for 2 single member wards for this area comprising a Welland ward based on Upper Welland [and] Little Malvern, Welland and Castlemorton parishes and a Longdon ward comprising the remaining part of the area; c) Kempsey and Powick - Powick: the name of the ward should reflect that the area covers Hanley Castle and Hanley Swan thus a proposal should be made that the ward name be 'Powick and The Hanleys'; d) North-western Malvern Hills: the proposals seem logical and are supported.
