Dear Sir/Madam

I am very perplexed as to why you would be thinking about changing the parish boundary so that Queen Hill and Holdfast move from Longdon to Ripple Parish Council.

I understand you want to connect river communities. This might make sense as a general rule but in our case it would be wrong to presume we have more in common with Ripple than Longdon.

QH and Holdfast are set at a high level above the river and never flood. Ripple is in the flood plain.  
QH and Holdfast have issues with Severn Trent water supply – when Longdon is cut off (regularly) so are we.  
QH and Holdfast rely on the same road network as Longdon. When a bridge closes we all have to use the same alternative routes. Likewise when a road floods.

QH, Holdfast and Longdon are on the same bit of ground, at the same height above the river, and we share the same resources. Your riverside communities plan makes no sense in our case.

Please leave the boundary where it is and focus your attention on something that needs it.
