Dear Sir or Madam

It is with disbelief I hear that there could be a possible change to the boundaries of Queenhill and Holdfast which could link them with Ripple.

We have had a very successful working relationship with Longdon, our adjoining neighbour and also with Castlemorton. The church parishes of Longdon, Queenhill and Holdfast, Bushley and Castlemorton are linked as LCBQ. The youngest children attend Castlemorton school. We have no interaction with Ripple at all.

The River Severn is a huge geographic divide between ourselves and Ripple. To get to Ripple we would have to go to Upton to cross the river or via the Mythe Bridge at Tewkesbury. Both these options necessitate a long drive round. Longdon is immediately next door to us and with which we have ties and local understanding on all sorts of issues.

To be lumped with Ripple does not make sense either geographically, socially or for administrative purposes. I hope note will be taken of this. Staying with Longdon is the best option.
