Comment text:

Under NO circumstances should the current Alfrick & Leigh Ward be linked to any part of the Malvern urban area. This occurs at county level to the intense dissatisfaction of residents in the MHDC ward. The ward is intensely rural, with small pockets of semi-suburban development. In contrast Malvern Link and West wards are highly urbanised. There are no points of commonality between the communities at any level and considerable local irritation at being effectively subservient to the urban priorities of Link. If it is thought necessary to group Alfrick & Leigh with another population centre, Rushwick would be of similar characteristics and has some interchange with Bransford. It would be prudent to consider splitting Rushwick into two though: the existing semi-rural community and a new community east of the A4440 which is de facto part of the Worcester city urban area. Other nearby communities such as Martley, Broadwas and Cotheridge have very limited connections with the ward and are unlikely to have common interests, except to a very limited extent with the Doddenham section of Knightwick & Doddenham combined parish.
