Review of Malvern Hills District Council Ward Boundaries I would like to suggest that the boundary between the Chase Ward and Guarlford Parish is adjusted. The eastern side of Hall Green is already within the Ecclesiastical boundary of Guarlford and it would make sense therefore to align the administrative boundary with the ecclesiastical boundary of Guarlford. This would increase the size of Guarlford Parish, reducing slightly the size of the large Chase Ward, but overall providing for a better balance with regard to District Councillors per elector. From the Malvern Hills Trust perspective of elected Trustees, such a change would provide a better balance of the electorate in MHT elections. As a resident of Hall Green I feel more associated with Guarlford Parish than with the Chase Ward. Residents of Hall Green are invited to events at Guarlford Village Hall and many do attend and support such functions. It is after all in easy walking distance of Hall Green. The Grapevine magazine, a Guarlford Parish publication is produced monthly for residents of Guarlford Parish and has always been delivered to Hall Green just within their ecclesiastical boundary. That way, we are always very much involved with Guarlford Parish already and aligning the administrative boundary to co-incide with that would make sense.
