Firstly, look back to 1970 when the council was conservative and there were 120 councillors with ward's such as Abrecrombe and Breckside. Secondly consider ward's such as Kensington and Fairfield, Speke Garston, Tuebrook and Stoneycroft. It is important that ward boundaries reflect communities. There is for instance a notable difference between Kensington end Fairfield so such ward's should be split. Where an equal number of electors can not be easily decided the area with higher deprivation should be smaller to reflect the workload.
