I believe that Croxteth Country Park (L12 0) should have it's own ward due to the amount of people residing here. It currently falls under the Croxteth ward which also contains Croxteth (L11), however it seems that all funds get directed to L11. This includes things such as Christmas decorations, neighbourhood initiatives, enhancements to the area, general maintenance such as tree cutting back, fixing potholes, fixing damaged pavements. Considering the high amount of council tax paid by the residents here, this does not seem to be fed back into the estate meaning the estate is declining in terms of how it looks.
