Thank you for providing the information on the web page informing us of the three legal factors the Commission uses to draw new boundaries. Based on your criteria the boundary for Parson Drove and Wisbech St Mary Ward should remain as it is. • The proposal has the A47 featuring in it, a physical barrier. • The proposal divides Murrow Village into two new wards therefore splitting community interests and identities. • The proposal does not make geographic sense for effective and convenient local government, because Murrow is without public transport links, whereas the existing ward does make geographic sense. • The proposal severs part of Murrow from Parson Drove when the facilities Murrow residents use are in Parson Drove. • The only thing I can see that might be achieved is that each councillor will represent the same number of voters as other councillors elsewhere in the authority. I do not think achieving that one factor outweighs the other factors that will have a negative impact on our rural villages. Therefore I object very strongly to the proposed changes.
