The LGBC proposal for changes to the Ward boundaries for Bookham have been described by Bookham Resident's Association Executive by the Spring 2022 Newsletter and by email. We wish to lodge an objection to the current boundary proposals from LGBC. The creation of an artificial group of residents called the Eastwick Park Ward between Fetcham and Bookham as described by the 2022 LGBC proposals is meaningless and the current Eastern boundary for Bookham needs to be maintained.
