I think that the identities of the villages of Bookham and Fetcham are important and the division of Bookham/Eastwick Park should definitely not be along Bookham High Street and Church Road which are the heart of Bookham village and its shopping centre. In general no boundary should divide properties on either side of a road, instead being along the back boundaries of the properties . The above division goes straight through the heart of Bookham and would make it very difficult, however friendly the wards are, for the councillors to work efficiently.

We, under the present boundaries, are in Fetcham parish, have a Fetcham address and are in Bookham North ward – not ideal.
