I object in the strongest terms to the proposed change in ward boundary. The proposed inclusion of Charlwood in to the Capel, Leigh and Newdigate would make it almost impossible to meet with or access my councillor in a way I need to. How many councillors will take seriously our complaints about the bottles of urine and faeces left by the taxi drivers picking up from Gatwick, and parking on yellow lines and in residents' parking bays? My ward would lose fair representation. Even if our residents have access to three district councillors, due to the huge increase in ward size means these councillors will have an unmanageable area to cover, and would be unfair on the councillors.
