As somebody who lived in Fetcham for 48 years and has recently moved to Bookham I feel uniquely qualified to comment on these proposals. Although we only moved half a mile, it is very clear that we have moved from one village to another. However, under these proposals, both our houses would have been in Eastwick Park, a totally fictitious area with no centre whatsoever.

> Residents of both Bookham are well aware of which village they live in, even those in the historic areas of Fetcham which were moved into a Bookham Ward some years ago still considered themselves residents of Fetcham. The proposals of the Residents Associations returning these to Fetcham would restore the ancient Parish Boundaries established over 1000 years ago. These might be considered outdated now but the two Churches, St Mary's in Fetcham and St Nicolas in Bookham still provide a focus for the two villages.
