The City of Southampton has 16 Local Government Wards. The Wards are different in size of population and the name of some Ward's do not reflect the area or the community they are supposed to represent. It seems correct that to have proper and effective local Government that the number of Ward's should increase. And some Ward's should have the names of the Ward's changed to reflect the area. No one thinks they live in Peartree, they live in either Sholing or Bitterne for example. Residents of Thornhill do not live in Bitterne Ward.
