Comment text:

Hi, I live [REDACTED] in Mackworth Ward. In answer to your question "What facilities do people share, such as parks, leisure centres or schools and shopping areas?" - I do not use any of the facilities in the part of Mackworth Ward which is west of the A38. I use Markeaton and Darley Parks for recreation, and would always look to city centre (via Ashbourne Road and Friargate) for any other facilities, as this is nearer than Mackworth District Centre and has a wider range of facilities. Whereas for those living in the western part, city centre facilities are beyond reasonable walking distance. In this respect, my needs are more closely aligned with those of the West End (Markeaton Street / Bridge Street area) in Darley Ward, than with the western part of Mackworth Ward. Another characteristic shared with the West End (and also Kedleston Road) is the proximity of the university: there are many Victorian terraced houses east of the A38 which are used as student accommodation, whereas I doubt that many students live in the council-built housing west of the A38. The A38 also forms a significant physical barrier between eastern and western parts of Mackworth Ward.
