Dear Commission, I am a resident in Chaddesden, and have been for a few years. I have also lived in Spondon. I understand these areas and communities well. Right now, Chaddesden is split between Chaddesden ward, and Derwent ward. The Boundary between the two, Chaddesden Park Road doesn't make any sense, as the houses across from each other are definitely in Chaddesden, but the area in Derwent has very little in common with Breadsall Hilltop, which it is in a ward with. This should be addressed by the proposals. Chaddesden Social Club, the Nottingham Road Fire station and 132nd Derby Scout Group, all of which are Chaddesden community services should be in Chaddesden ward. Similarly, St Albans church supports the Chaddesden community, and is in Derwent ward. Spondon is pretty isolated by the ring road and A52. However it does come across the roundabout and connects to Chaddesden via Acord Way and Derby Road. The community in Spondon is similar to the community in the sunny grove/derby road triangle, and these could be potentially merged, if Spondon needed to gain voters as I know that it is short. Alternatively, a two member ward for Spondon - entirely the other side of the ring road, could work. Fundamentally, Chaddesden needs to be reunited for any ward map to make sense in this area of Derby. Thanks for listening to me, ██████
