Comment text:

I am writing to express my objection to the proposed boundaries for the new Timperley Central ward (Trafford Council). I am specifically concerned that the proposed boundaries will divide the Broomwood estate - which is a self-contained community in its own right and which comprises a large percentage of Trafford's social housing. Dividing such a community in an arbitrary manner for administrative reasons is contrary to the objectives of the boundary commission and undermines public trust. Due to the circumstances of the pandemic, suitable consultation has not taken place. If it had, I am confident that the mistake of dividing the Broomwood estate would have been spotted at an earlier stage. The estate has many local amenities and services including a post office, a community café, a local community centre, dentist, medical centre as well as Broomwood Primary School. The Broomwood is also serviced by the number 11 bus. In the past I have only had to travel to Timperley when my local post office hasn't been able to provide services. I also attend the regular 'Friday Club' at Broomwood Community Centre which has catered for people right across the estate for 65 years. There is a community spirit on the Broomwood which is evidenced by the regular litter-picks on Broomwood Community Park near my house. I have attached a document which more comprehensively explains what is meant by 'The Broomwood' and which highlights the various community assets within it. Thank you, [REDACTED]
