These proposals appear to be drawn up by person or persons that have no knowledge of Redditch, its neighborhoods and its history. I will give one major example of this:- The proposals for Headless Cross and Crabbs Cross are non-sensible or practical (they hint at political maneuvering and fixing boundaries to suit one political party}. The area of the two "Cross's" are adjacent to each other and local roads and housing estates interrelate with each other.
