What is the thinking in combining such diverse areas to be all represented by the same person(s) - & sharing the same neighbourhood funds for allocation? How easily would that work in practice? Not all, but many parts of Blagreaves are wealthy. The cost of houses changes drastically one side of Stenson Road versus the other as just one example. The Austin estate was recognised in I think it was the 90s as one of the most deprived nationally. People in sunnyhill, especially sunnyhill Ave and tiwards old Normanton village, have far more issues in common with others in that area than they do people on much of blag Lane, Field rise, Briarwood way & Littleover Lane areas. How will splitting the Austin estate and new parts added of core sunnyhill ensure their interests are heard & represented /advocated effectively? How should a neighbourhood board decide between funds going to one half of that area or somewhere in Old Blagreaves.. (&coordinate that with what other wards may be giving the remainder of core sunnyhill, maybe one street along/within the same 1split estate) ?)
