### Comment text:

The division of NG ward into 3 smaller wards appears to make no discernible difference - the overall boundary to the old NG ward hasn't changed. We have 3 councillors..... who are hardly to be seen or heard by ordinary people living here .....and looks like they will just divvy up NG between themselves. Despite being on social media they post only sporadically with any news about their work , through Norris Green Labour and rarely reply to email. And they never from their personal social media accounts, unlike say Ann O'Byrne who is both very active in her ward day to day and is always reporting back and engaging with the electorate in her ward online. So, as part of these new changes there should be a minimum expected standard of resident engagement carried out by all councillors across all wards - there should be a bar set. NG councillors are never heard from between elections if at all (except when it is May and they suddenly pop out of the woodwork to have photos taken in the neighbourhood they rarely visit and do not know). When they do engage locally it is mainly at the Alt Valley run Ellergreen Cebtre - their pet project - where their mates have jobs. The demography of NG has changed due to the new mainly privately owned NGV estate. The concerns of owners occupiers with jobs and businesses are ignored. It's all about people on benefits. There needs to equity of action and engagement for everyone in NG regardless of tenure or income profile.
