I've looked at the proposed Godalming wards and have a few specific comments, set out by section of the draft recommendations report (October 2021). 55. a) The inclusion of Croft & Brighton Roads into Holloway is a good improvement, it was getting very inconsistent with new developments on the east of Croft Road. The suggested town parish Croft seems unnecessarily small compared to other Godalming wards though and is far too specific. 55. b) The site of new retirement homes at the north east corner of Brighton Road, Godalming should probably be in Holloway as its entrance is on Brighton Road. The two adjacent properties (Olde Steppe House, Springwood Cottage) are also in Holloway while this site is currently carved out into Central & Ockford. Waverley planning application WA/2020/2123, postcode GU7 1NS, OS ref SU 97306 43784. 55. c) The South Winds property/buildings at the south west end of Grove Road, Godalming have been included into Godalming Holloway when the remainder of the road and access is via Central & Ockford, I'd suggest all of Grove Road should be in Central & Ockford. UPRN: 100061616419, GU7 1RE. 55. d) The property 1a Orchardfield Road, Farncombe is part of the Farncombe & Catteshall ward but may be better placed in Binscombe & Charterhouse with the rest of the road. UPRN: 10091111559, GU7 3PB. 55. e) The Central & Ockford boundary with Binscombe & Charterhouse along Borough Road, Chalk Road and Bridge Road seems unnecessarily complex and it could simply follow the river, making the whole of the Burys field part of the Binscombe & Charterhouse ward. In practice this wouldn't move any electors between wards but would make the boundary clearer and couple the green areas near these roads to the B&C ward. 56. The Godalming prefix seems helpful, with the possible exception of the Farncombe & Catteshall ward where it's perhaps redundant.
