I am supportive of the general principles of all of this, but I feel two of the proposed ward names are misleading, and do not reflect as helpfully all the communities that they represent. I would suggest the following changes might improve general understanding of the areas covered: Farnham Firgrove and Shortheath, doesn't cover the area east of tilford road at all. The areas involved are Shortheath, Weydon, Firgrove, the station, and Boroomleaf. My suggestion is Weydon & Broomleaf, as everyone in Farnham would immediately know roughly what that covered, but if you allowed three words, one could still include Shortheath. Churt and Frensham covers many other villages not named, and would therefore be utterly misleading. Frensham is essential to include as it is a large parish, and no other name covers that, but Churt is just one of several villages. Further, Churt is right in the corner of the word, and has no more level of amenities/destination than Thursley or Tilford. the one thing that everywhere apart from Frensham does have in common is that they are just about in or on the edge of the Devil's Punch Bowl. therefore, my suggestion is Frensham and the Devil's Punch Bowl. It is a bit unusual, but I think most residents would immediately get it.
