We aim to make sure Slough councillors represent a similar number of electors


## Currently there are:

- 6 wards that are more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- 2 ward(s) that are more than $20 \%$ away from the average


## From elections in 2023:

- 42 councillors
- 21 wards
- 2 councillors per ward


Slough will move towards:

- No wards being more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,644 electors
