Given the growth of developments and proposed developments in Southam, the town itself would be based on equal ward numbers be able to sustain three Councillors, Long Itchington realistically again because of high developments should get a Councillor in its own right with Stockon most probably pairing with Napton rather than the current situation of Napton being with Fenny Compton.
