There have been many more home built in the last several years in Cranleigh and as a village we have received more than the lions's share, as a result, the electorate has increased as has the workload for the three Councillors that represent the ward. I do not think that there should be any reduction in the number of Councillors representing this ward. Cranleigh East too in a survey taken in the last three years, was described as a deprived ward as it had the least facilities and the least ability access those in the village and surrounding towns. It also has the most dense population and a high number of original social housing, some built before the second world war. Facilities in Cranleigh are about one and a half miles away, the casework as a result of these issues is considerably higher than the average in Waverley wards. The village lies 10 -11 miles from Dorking, Horsham, Guildford and Godalming. It is 21 miles from Farnham.
