Comment text:

As district councillor for Pershore I fully support our existing three person ward. While it is currently unique in Wychavon, it suits the needs of our town. We have a very distinct identity within the town but it cannot be cleanly broken down into different areas, with no physical boundary that separates us and a clear sense of community throughout. I completely support the view that the town should remain a ward. I would also strongly urge not adding any smaller parishes into the boundary as their voices would be not heard in the same way and their identity would be shadowed by the town. I also support the views of the parish councils of Bishampton and Pinvin that the Pinvin ward should remain. The role of the landfill and Throckmorton airfield in the centre of the ward does bring a unique set of challenges for the parishes that I have begun to understand since being elected county councillor for the area in May. There is a distinct series of issues that come with this location and, with all the parishes under one councillor it is possible to really focus attention and ensure the residents are listened to. I would therefore hope that these views are taken into account when boundary changes are made.
