Multiple divisions should be removed - they can not function as well as single divisions and likely create more work for the elected councillors. It must be possible to define a full set of single divisions across Shropshire. All new urban housing areas must be incorporated within their local towns. An example of this exists on the eastern (ESE) edge of Shrewsbury, where ~150 Shrewsbury homes are contained within the rural division of Severn Valley. The residents live in Shrewsbury, using Shrewsbury services, but they are combined with rural residents and rural issues. Conversely, they are not included in the town in which they are located. This is due to the town's border being steadily extended and this opportunity needs to be taken to address this matter for all Shropshire towns with new periphery housing.
