Silverstone Boundary Review Response

We are fully supportive of retaining Silverstone and Rural South Northamptonshire as a three member Ward, which works well at present, allowing for cross member working and support. We do not believe in splitting the Ward as this will create silos which will not be as effective as a team-based approach. Many of the issues in the rural areas are similar and with HS2 taking in the north of the Ward this places a great deal of work in one area which can be shared. An example of this is attending Parish Council meetings which often clash with Council led meetings and or other Parish Council meetings. We would recommend that Thorpe Mandeville should stay part of the ward and not be included in with Middleton Cheney which is what the village PC wish also. In addition we would see Greatworth being part of the Middleton Cheney Ward. Geographically Thorpe Mandeville sits the same side of the B4252 as all the rest of the our Silverstone villages whilst Greatworth is closer to Halse and Brackley and works in unison with Middleton Cheney; Thorpe Mandeville follows the HS2 alignment between Sulgrave, and Chipping Warden adjacent to Culworth.

We would prefer the name to be Rural South Northamptonshire, excluding Silverstone as the inclusion of Silverstone means nothing to those people who live in the other Ward Villages.
