We do not agree with the changes. We currently live in Loddon, and whilst there does not appear to be a boundary change in our area, we prefer to keep Loddon as the name of this ward rather than change it to East Woodley. The name Loddon refers to the Ward's position near the banks of the Loddon, which current residents easily identify with, and we prefer that the council keep this name and the unusual names associated with other Woodley wards rather than lump them all together and differentiate them simply as a compass named part of Woodley. In my view, the naming exercise shows lack of imagination by the local Councillors who simply see renaming as a blunt tool to identify the part of Woodley a resident lives without the need to consult a map, rather than taking into account the more individual naming of the wards and long held allegiances of local residents to these names and locations.
