**Related subject:** Caterham Valley

The proposal to remove Stafford Road and its offshoot roads such as High Trees, Milner Road etc is flawed on a number of points.

- 1) The geography of this area: Church Hill/Waller Lane follows a natural boundary, a steeply wooded hill that towers above Stafford Road, making the road firmly "Valley" for its entire length, (over a mile). The railway is the lowest point on the valley bottom, and Stafford Road only marginally above it.
- 2) If Stafford Road were to be removed to Queens Park as suggested, Residents in Stafford Road would lose part of their identity with Caterham Valley.
- 3) If Stafford Road were to be removed to Queens Park, its Residents would need to vote at a polling station on Caterham Hill. I predict this would lead to a reduction in voting.
